It's time to renew your Medicaid coverage

With greater access to healthcare comes better health outcomes! Medicaid coverage has been shown to promote long-term improvements in health and well-being. That's why it is critical for you and your family to maintain your Medicaid benefits!

If you are a Nebraska resident, Medicaid coverage renewals are underway. To maintain your benefits, you must complete the renewal process as soon as possible.

Here's how to ensure you don't lose your Medicaid benefits:

Don't miss the deadline!

Check your mail for a Verification Request or Renewal Form from DHHS and provide all the requested information by the deadline indicated.

Missed the deadline? It's okay. You've got options.

You can still complete the renewal process within 30 days after the deadline.

Update your contact information with DHHS

If you have not received a Verification Request or Renewal Form from DHHS by now, make sure your contact information with DHHS is up to date:

Lost your Medicaid coverage? Here's what you should know:

- You may still be eligible. Find out if your family may still qualify for Medicaid coverage by contacting DHHS at **1-855-632-7633**
- You have a right to appeal. The back of your Notice of Action from DHHS has key information on this process.

Starting January 1, 2024, Nebraska Medicaid extended postpartum coverage from **60 days to 12 months!** Early findings are already showing the benefits of 12 months of postpartum Medicaid, including increased uptake of postpartum, mental health, and contraceptive services and reduced risk of medical debt.
